# Walkabout Wrexham - Evening Walks 2025

#### Please Note

All the walks are lead by trained volunteers.

For all the walks, everyone should meet at 18.15 for an 18.30 start.

Distances, ascents and times for the walks are all approximate and routes may need to be amended on the day depending on the weather, size of the group or other changed circumstances.

Walks are roughly graded with harder walks being longer, likely to cross rough ground, go over stiles and include inclines which may be steep so requiring walkers to have a good level of fitness.

Walkers will need suitable footwear (boots for the harder walks) and clothing. They should bring water and a snack and for the longer walks.

#### Thursday 26th June

About 5 miles (8 km) with 880 ft (270 m) of ascent.....Harder

An approximately 2.5-3 hour circular walk from **Trevor Basin** up towards Trevor Hall Woods and Offa's Dyke Path. Meet at 18.15 for an 18.30 start in the Chapel Tea Rooms car park (£1 charge), Station Road, Trevor. (LL20 7TP Grid Ref SJ 271 423 ///cadet.pasta.half). No dogs please. John W leading.

#### Thursday 3rd July

About 4 miles (6.25 km) with 460 ft (140 m) of ascent......Moderate

An approximately 2-2.5 hour circular walk from **Brynteg through Brymbo and Pentre Broughton**. Meet at 18.15 for an 18.30 start in the Forge Road Surgery car park, 56 Darby Road, Brynteg (LL11 5RR Grid Ref SJ 305 521 ///jumps.credit.news). No dogs please. Rob and Barbara leading.

#### Thursday 10th July

About 5.5 miles (8.9 km) with 1000 ft (300m) of ascent ......Harder

An approximately 3 hour circular walk from **Dolywern in the Ceiriog Valley** across fields, along tracks and roads over the hills to Pontfadog. Meet at 18.15 for an 18.30 start in the car park opposite The Oliver Jones Memorial Hall on Maes y Wern off the B4500 in Dolywern in the Ceiriog Valley (LL20 7BA Grid Ref SJ 222 371 ///attitudes.flaunting.kennels). About 4.5 miles (7.2 km) with 500 ft (150 m) of ascent	.Moderate

### Thursday 24th July

About 5 miles (8.0 km) and flat (56 ft/17m) of ascent.....Easier

An approximately 2.5 hour circular walk from **Rossett** via paths, across agricultural fields, along some tracks and short spells of rural roadway. The walk will pass through the villages and hamlets of Burton, Burton Green and Honkley and afterwards there will be opportunity to stop for refreshments in Rossett. Meet at 18.15 for an 18.30 start in the free car park on the left side of Station Road, Rossett (LL12 OHE Grid Ref SJ 364 571 ///coast.gushes,bloom). No dogs please. Osian leading.

### Thursday 31st July

About 3 miles (4.7 km) with 130 ft (40 m) of ascent.....Easy

An approximately 1.5 hour circular stroll around **Hope** by the River Alyn and along a short section of Wat's Dyke Way. Meet at 18.15 for an 18.30 start in the free car park across the road from the new Family Health Centre on Hawarden Road (A550) in Hope (LL12 9NP Grid Ref SJ 309 578 ///exclusive.this.gardens). About 3.5 miles (5.6 km) with 165 ft (50 m) of ascent.....Easier

An approximately 1.5-2 hour circular walk in and around **Erddig Country Park, Wrexham**.
