



## Walkabout Wrexham - Evening Walks 2026

### **PLEASE NOTE**

#### **For all the walks, meet at 18.15 for an 18.30 start.**

- All the walks are free of charge and there is no need to book in advance.
- The walks will be led by experienced volunteers.
- Distances, ascents and times for the walks are all approximate and routes may need to be amended on the day depending on the weather, the size of the group or other changed circumstances.
- Walks are roughly graded with harder walks being longer, likely to cross uneven ground, go over stiles and include inclines which may be steep so requiring walkers to have a good level of fitness. Some walks will cross farmland where there may be grazing livestock so dogs are not permitted on most of the walks.
- Walkers will need suitable footwear (boots for the moderate and harder walks) and clothing. They should bring water and a snack and for the longer walks.

### **Friday 19 June**

5 miles, (8 km) with 1400 ft (425 m) of ascent.....Harder  
A 3 hour circular walk from the centre of Llangollen via the North Berwyn Way. Meet by the bridge opposite The Bridge End Hotel (LL20 8RY Grid Ref SJ 215 422  
///searcher.perused.spindles). No dogs please. Leaders Bill and Roz.

### **Friday 26 June**

4.5 miles (7.5 km) with 65 ft (50 m) of ascent.....Easier  
A linear 2.5-3 hour walk along Wat's Dyke from Ruabon to Wrexham. Meet outside The Wynnstay Arms, High Street, Ruabon (LL14 6BL Grid Ref SJ 303 438  
///digestion.comedy.clown). The walk follows Wat's Dyke Way across fields, finishing at Felin Puleston free car park on Ruabon Road, Wrexham opposite Booker Wrexham. No dogs please. Leaders Dermot and Pat W.

To get to Ruabon, the Oswestry bus leaving Wrexham Bus Station at 17.22 stops by Felin Puleston and arrives outside the Wynnstay Arms in Ruabon about 20 minutes later.

### **Friday 3 July**

4.7 miles (7.5 km) and flat (56 ft/17m) of ascent.....Easier  
An approximately 2.5-3 hour circular walk from Rossett via paths, across agricultural fields, along some tracks and on short spells of rural roadway. The walk will head towards the hamlet of Trevalyn and then follow the River Alyn downstream and along rural roads towards Parkside before returning over the meadows via Cox Wood and Trevalyn Hall. Afterwards there will be an opportunity to stop for refreshments in Rossett. Meet in the free car park on the left side of Station Road, Rossett (LL12 0HE Grid Ref SJ 364 571 ///coast.gushes.bloom). No dogs please. Leaders Osian and John H.

### **Friday 10 July**

4-5 miles (6.5-8 km) with up to 400 ft (120 m) of ascent.....Moderate  
An approximately 2.5-3 hour circular walk in and around **Minera Quarry** taking in the best of the flora and wildlife on view. Meet at Minera Quarry car park on Maes y Ffynnon Road (LL11 3DE Grid Ref SJ 258 519 *///shunted.typically.toolbar*). No dogs please. Leaders John I and Pat W.

### **Friday 17 July**

4 miles (6.5 km) with 325 ft (100 m) of ascent.....Easier  
An approximately 2.5 hour circular walk in and around **Erddig Country Park, Wrexham**. Meet in the large free car park at Felin Puleston on Ruabon Road, opposite Booker Wrexham (LL13 7RF Grid Ref SJ 325 494 *///explain.pinks.lawfully*). No dogs please. Leaders Jenny R and Geoff.

### **Friday 24 July**

4 miles (6.5 km) with 150 ft (45m) of ascent.....Easier  
An approximately 2.5 hour figure-8 walk around **Bangor-on-Dee** following the loop of the River Dee and passing through the Community Garden and Orchard, then up an incline with views of the racecourse and mountains beyond before returning to the village. Meet by The Buck, High Street, Bangor-on-Dee (LL13 0BU Grid Ref SJ 389 455 *///apparatus.horseshoe.weekday*). No dogs please. Leaders Roz, Alwyn and Pat W.

### **Friday 31 July**

4.5 miles (7.25 km) with 1030 ft (315 m) of ascent.....Harder  
An approximately 2.5-3 hour circular walk through the grounds of **Chirk** Castle, along Offa's Dyke Path, then down to Castle Mill and back up through the estate to the finish. Meet in the large free car park by the Health Centre behind The Hand Hotel off the B5070 (Church St) in Chirk (LL14 5DH Grid Ref SJ 291 378 *///acid.majority.rebounder*). No dogs please. Leaders Bill and Kelvin.

### **Friday 7 August**

2.5 miles (4 km) with 50 ft (15 m) of ascent.....Easy  
An approximately 1.5 hour walk from **Wenffrwd Nature Reserve, Llangollen** along the canal towpath to Llangollen then back on the disused railway line. Meet in the Nature Reserve (P&D) car park on the A539 just over 0.5 miles beyond The Sun, Trevor and opposite the green and white sign for the Llandyn Holiday Park (LL20 7UH Grid Ref SJ 232 425 *///hunter.departure.adjusted*). Well behaved dogs welcome. Leaders Hazel and Geoff.

### **Friday 14 August**

3 miles (4.9 km) with about 260 ft (80 m) of ascent.....Easier  
An approximately 2 hour circular walk from **Chirk** along the canal towpath over Chirk Aqueduct to The Poachers Pocket then through fields near Chirk Bank and down the lane to Pont Faen before returning through Lady Margaret's Wood. Meet by the mini-roundabout just past Caffi Wylfa on Castle Road (B4500), Chirk (LL14 5BS Grid Ref SJ 286 375 *///tissue.umbrellas.mirroring*). No dogs please. Leaders Val, Jeff and Betty.
